COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

SUMMARY OF PRINCIPAL CHANGES TO BE INTRODUCED FROM 2012

GENERAL

Alteration of wording throughout the document to reflect the change in name of the Rules governing body from the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews to the R & A Rules Limited.

GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING PLAY IN CORNWALL GOLF UNION COMPETITIONS

Clause 8 – Reference the use of Buggies in competitions

A change of wording is required to adopt the EGU Transportation Policy in respect of the use of buggies for people with disabilities.

THE CORNWALL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

Eligibility Clause

Updated and simplified to reflect a more uniformed condition in line with EGU recommendations.

COUNTY WEEK DAILY COMPETITIONS

Jamieson Challenge Trophy – Change to a stableford format from a par competition and to be played on the Saturday morning of County Week replacing the Saturday Medal.

The Lawrance Cup - To be played on the Monday of County Week instead of the Thursday.

The Western Morning News Challenge Cup – The removal of the 2 handicap divisions the winners of which playoff for the trophy, to be replaced by 1 division, maximum handicap 18 and thus doing away with the need to stage a playoff on either the Friday or Saturday.

TEAM EVENTS

The Cornwall Team Championship

The CTC Plate competition to cease after 2012.

The Presidents Cup

The introduction of a new team competition called the Presidents Cup. The competition is open to any clubs not playing in the CTC and with 9 players per team, 3 from Handicap Categories 1, 2, & 3. The format will be match play off handicap throughout the winter months.

The Frank Wills Salver

The handicap range of players eligible to compete will be changed to 5 – 12 handicap and thus removing the minimum required combined handicap of 6.

The Summer Scratch League

The competition ceased in 2011.

INDIVIDUAL AND PAIRS EVENTS

The Gold Medals

The competition ceased in 2010.

The Cornish Closed Championship

The rewording of the clause to state that the competition is open to PGA Professionals of Clubs affiliated to the Cornwall Golf Union and to amateurs as defined in the General Conditions.

The Seniors Championship

The introduction of a maximum handicap allowed of 18
